

## NASENI Week 2025: Chairman Inaugurates 11 Sub-Committees

he National Agency for Science and Engineering Infrastructure (NASENI) has inaugurated the leadership and members of eleven (11) subcommittees charged with the planning and organizing the landmark NASENI Week 2025, scheduled to hold on October 20-24, 2025.

The forthcoming "NASENI Week" is the first of its kind since the establishment of the Agency 33 years ago (1992 to be precise).

The inauguration was conducted by the Chairman of NASENI Week Planning Committee Dr. Dahiru Mohammed who was represented by Dr. (Mrs.) Nonye Onyechi, Coordinating Director of Planning and Business Development NASENI headquarters, Abuja.

Speaking during the inauguration, Dr. Mohammed stated that NASENI Week 2025 is designed to showcase the

Agency's innovations, partnerships, and national contributions. He emphasized that the event aims to reposition NASENI as a key driver of industrialisation in Nigeria, through the promotion of technology, investment, and collaboration across both public and private sectors.

The weeklong event is expected to convene stakeholders from government, industry, academia, and development partners, both within and outside Nigeria. It will serve as a platform for knowledge sharing, product exhibitions, investment promotion, and policy dialogue.

"We are also aiming to strengthen NASENI's visibility at both national and international levels while deepening public understanding of our mandate and relevance," Dr. Mohammed noted, he said urging committee members to demonstrate commitment, creativity, and

teamwork in discharging their duties.

The inaugurated sub-committees and their chairmen are: Programme Development and Secretariat – Dr. (Mrs.) Nonye Onyechi; Logistics and Maintenance- Mrs. Grace Magaji (S/A Administration to the EVC); Media and Publicity- Mr. Olusegun Samuel Ayeoyenikan, Director, Information, New Media and Protocol.

Others are: Investment and Deal Room- Engr. Anas Balarabe Yazid, Coordinator, Project Management Office; Exhibition, Marketing and Sales- Engr. Bernard Ozigi, Director, Business Development and Special Assistant to the EVC on Special Duties; Protocol and Security- Mr. Hashimu Dalhatu; Community Engagement: Engr. Dr. Samuel Olusunle, Research Director;

The rest are: Finance and Sponsorship- Mr. Ibrahim Baba Dauda, Coordinating Director, Finance & Accounts; Health and Safety- Engr. Dr. Abdulrasheed Agava, Ag.
